Dan Welihan called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Board members present: Don Gezon, Kay Forster, Bruce Gauthier, Jeanette Mateer and Nadene Delana.

Absent: Mary Ellen Enos, joined meeting at 9:03 a.m.

Also present Library Director Brice Bush.

Approval of Minutes: Kay Forster made a motion to accept the minutes from the February 13, 2025 regular meeting as presented. Jeanette Mateer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report, Including Payment of Bills: Nadene Delana reported on the financials. Bruce Gauthier made a motion to accept the financial report as presented and Don Gezon seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Director's Report:

Special programming in February included Take Your Child to the Library Day, Wood You Make My Valentine, Lip Balm and Sugar Scrub workshop, and Tunes & Chili with Dale Reiger, Lori Cleland, and John Gravlin. In March you're invited to Spring Break at the Library with programs offered through the week beginning March 24 with Holi Colors!in the children's garden at 5:30 p.m., March 25 Storytime at 10:15 a.m. and Acrylic Paint Class (ages 8 and above) at 4 p.m., March 26 Legos and a movie at 2 p.m., March 27 Clay Workshop for ages 7 - 17 at 3:30 p.m., and March 28 Rock into Spring with rock painting from noon - 2 p.m. in the Children's area. April brings the therapy dog "Grizzly Bear" to meet children and families on April 9, Herbal Tea Tasting at 6 p.m. on April 22, Earth Week Expo on Saturday, April 26, and a chance to learn how to "Organize and De-clutter your Life" on April 29. Programs to highlight in May include a screening of "The Fish Thief: A Great Lakes Mystery" at 6 p.m. on May 6 and a Community Shred Day from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 10 planned for the main parking lot of the Library.

There have been several small facility issues addressed with Priestly Services such as replacement of baseboards and ceiling tiles, removal of shelving, elimination of scrap and trash.
